  - Man created from blood & bone of Marduk
  - Man = laborers for Gods
- From Egypt:
  - Ra named all things on earth, which grew when named
  - Created man last
  - Ra descended onto Earth & ruled as 1<sup>st</sup> pharaoh
- From China:
  - Nu Gua fashioned man from mud
  - Taught men & women how to procreate
  - Man = her companions
- From Greece:
  - Zeus & gods created man to amuse them as they watched from Mt. Olympus
- From Book of Genesis:
  - God created man to subdue Earth & rule over it in his name

- Humans evolved over 100s of 1000s of yrs from more primitive ancestors.

## Scientific view:

- Humanity = blip on global timeline
- First *hominids* = 3-4 million yrs ago
- Succeeded by *Homo Erectus* "handy man"
- Thinking humans" Homo sapiens
  - Appeared 75-40,000 yrs ago
  - Created culture
  - Culture allowed for "progress"
    - Stone Age to Bronze Age

- Bronze Age Centers of Civilizations
  - Mesopotamian = Sumer; Babylonia; Assyria
  - Nile River Valley = Egypt
  - Near East = Hittites
  - Indus River Valley = Indus culture
  - Yellow River Valley = Shang Dynasty
