- Last major push = 1683 at Vienna

- Bazaars = wonders of world
- Regulated economy
- Dhimmi
 - Legal restrictions
 - Jizya

- Ottoman Decline = slow
 - Empire at limits 17th cen
 - Powerful rivals
 - Corruption/incompetency of bureaucracy
 - Peasants squeezed
 - Poor imperial administration
 - Rise of European power
 - Technology
 - Janissaries block change
 - Ottoman fleet smashed
 - Circumnavigation of Africa
 - Islamic ego

- Safavid Empire
 - Challenged Ottomans & Mughals
 - Center = Iran
 - Empire = theocracy
 - State religion = Shi'a Islam
 - All other religions banned
 - Founded by Safavids
 - Sufism
 - Founder = Safi al-Din
 - Safavids = "brotherhood"
 - Allegiance to "hidden Imam"
 - ─ 15th cen = embraced religious-militarism
 - Waged jihad
 - Empire created by Shah Isma'il
 - Declares Shi'ism = state religion
 - Launches conversion campaign
 - Brings in Shi'ite scholars = sadrs
 - Religion = tool of state

- Strengths
 - Strong central gov't
 - Location
 - Cultural center
 - Patrons of artists
 - Isfahan = capitol
- Decline in 17th cen
 - Complacency & corruption
 - Power passed to ulama
 - Develop theory = Mujtahid
 - Europeans "interlope"
 - Provincial rebellions
 - Russia & Ottomans attack
- End = 1720s
 - Afshar Rebellion
 - Nader Shah
 - Anointed Mujtahid
 - Founds Afsharid Dynasty
 - Shahs & Ulama share power
 - 1979 = dynasty overthrown
 - Power shifts to Ayatollahs

- Mughal Empire
 - Center = India & Pakistan
 - Mughals = minority
 - Majority = Hindu
 - Changed India
 - Muslims in India

 - Mughals = descendants of Mongols
 - Retained warrior skills
 - Founder = Barbur
 - Enters India 1504
 - Captures Delhi
 - Imposes rule
 - Broad-minded
 - Empire built on toleration
 - Humayun
 - Bad emperor
 - Reign = disastrous for Mughals
